Our goal is to present hands-on, creative science activities that engage and excite students from diverse backgrounds. The program will implement a hands-on science curriculum, designed by the BUGSS team. Lessons will be 3 hours each day. The teaching assistants should be willing to follow the lead of the instructor and provide support. Assistants will be responsible for working most closely with small groups of up to 8 students.

- Some research experience working in a lab setting
- Experience or interest in working with students (required).
- Willingness to learn and adhere to basic lab safety requirements and procedures
- The ability to and enthusiasm for interacting with diverse individuals
